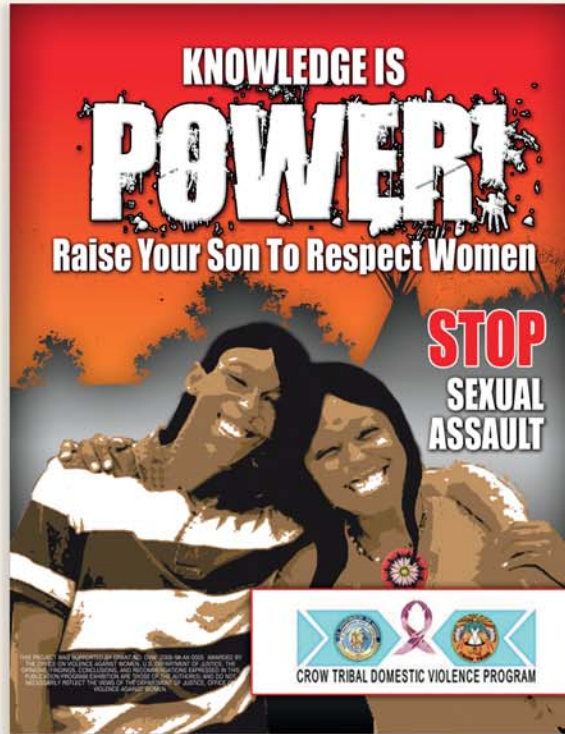
Everything that is heard and done is strictly confidential.

Visions Statement

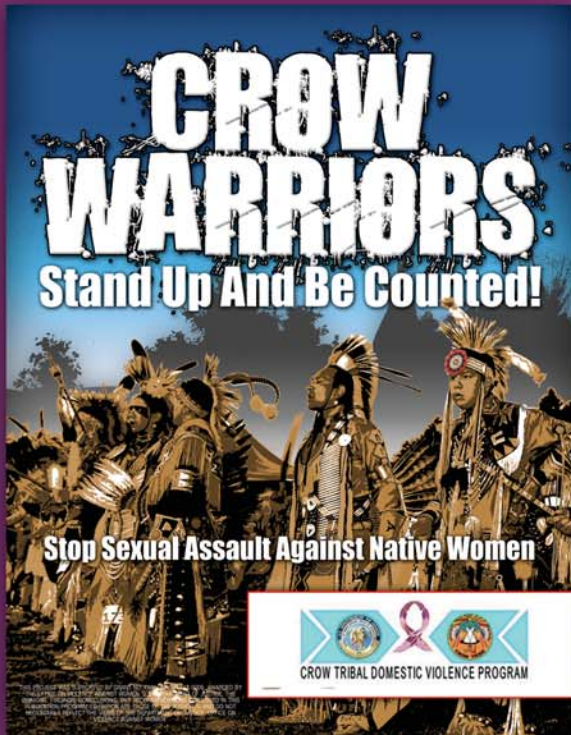
Our vision is to see happy and healthy families and individuals deal with their issues without violence and to provide a safe environment for their families, without any violence of any kind.
